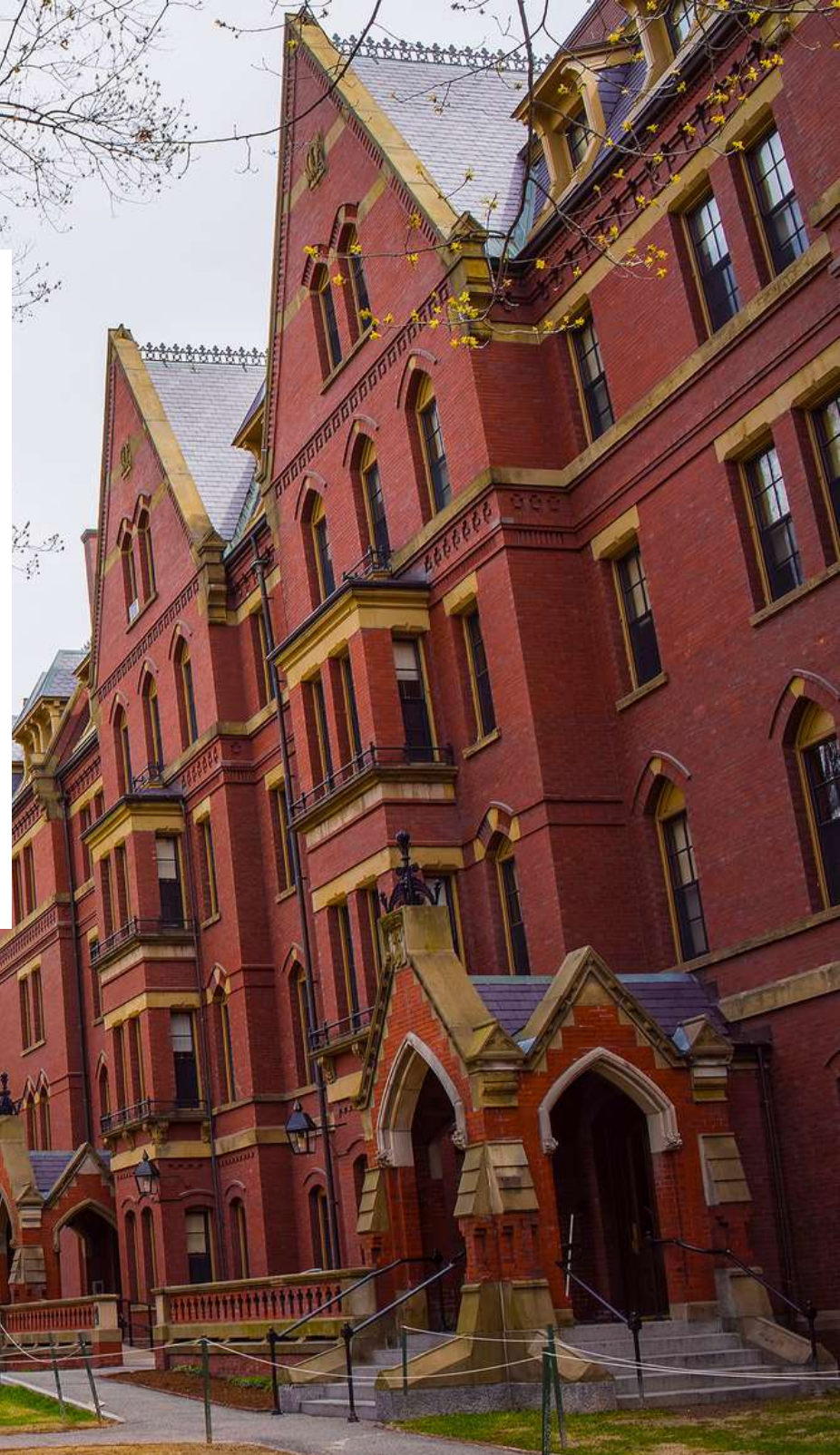

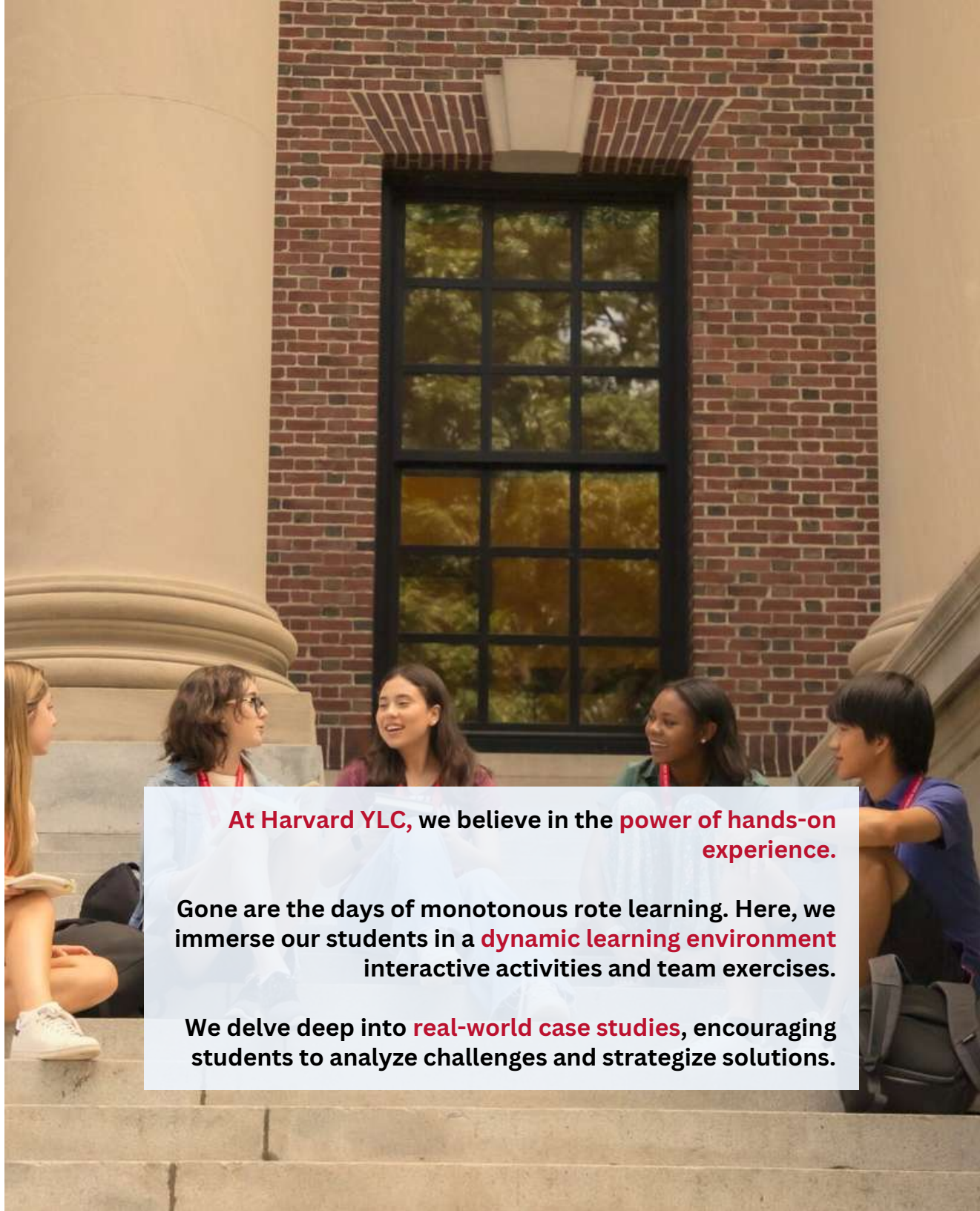

**Engage Actively:** Students are not passive learners; they actively engage, solve problems, and make decisions in their education.

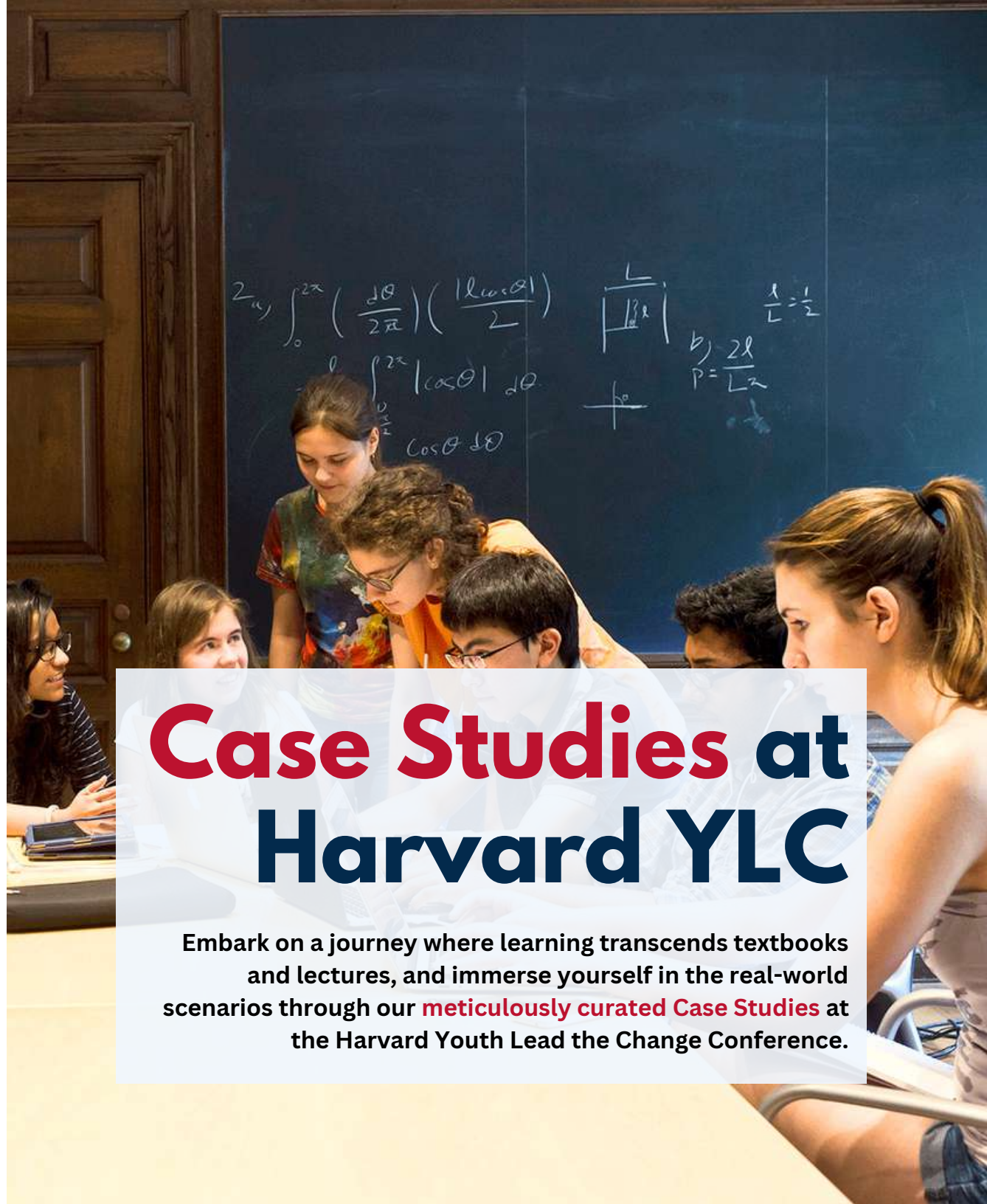
**Step into Real Scenarios:** Case studies bridge theory and real-world application, enabling students to apply classroom knowledge to practical scenarios.
