To join the program, high school students will have to fill out an application form & are selected based on the quality of their responses, with a selection rate of 10%.


4 Days Immersion Experience The course offers a unique 4-day immersive experience where students participate in various activities and sessions designed to enhance their leadership skills and knowledge.


